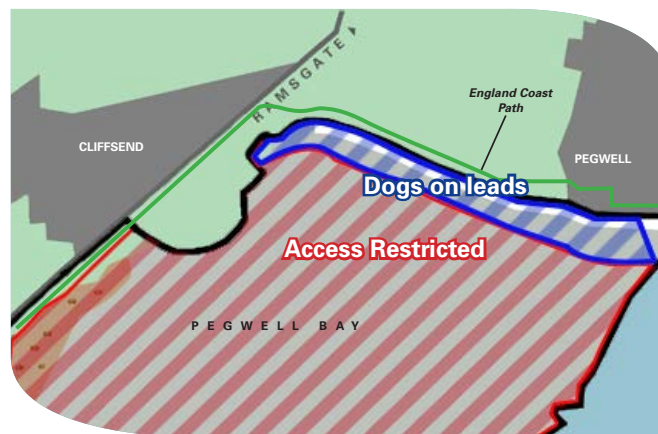


Help protect the amazing wildlife of Sandwich & Pegwell Bay

The mudflats here are of international importance, providing a vital refuge for many species of wildfowl and waders. These birds are vulnerable to disturbance and need a safe haven in which to feed and rest. Please take great care not to disturb them by keeping dogs on leads and observing the access restrictions as shown on the map.



How to find us

By train – the country park is 3 miles from Ramsgate station. Sandwich Bay is 2 miles from Sandwich station.

By bus – numbers 87 & 88 from Sandwich or Ramsgate stop at Cliffsend village.

By car – the country park is signposted from the A256 between Ramsgate and Sandwich. For Sandwich Bay, follow signs to the golf courses, entry is via a toll gate at the end of Sandown Road (Tel: 01304 612061 for current charge).

Opening times

Pegwell Bay Country Park opens 8.30am, closes 7.30pm or dusk if earlier. A fee is charged for parking.

Facilities and activities at Pegwell Bay Country Park

Nature trail with information panels, birdwatching hide, one mile of easy access coast path, open-air café (operates most days), toilets, free annual events programme.
