 third parties without their consent. As new Coastal Wardens & Guardians your details held by the Thanet
 Coast Project (Thanet Council) will also be shared with the Kent Wildlife Trust as part of the 'Guardians of
 the Deep' partnership project, with support from the Heritage Lottery Fund.
- Photographs are often taken at NEKMPA/ Thanet Coast/ Guardians of the Deep (partners eg Kent Wildlife Trust) activities & these are sometimes subsequently used for publicity purposes. NEKMPA / Thanet Coast Project will always give due consideration to an individual's right to privacy & respect before publishing any photographs or featuring any individual in writing. If anyone does not wish to be featured in NEKMPA/ Thanet Coast Project publicity under any circumstances it is your responsibility to inform project staff.
- Volunteer work often involves vulnerable groups such as the infirm, elderly, mentally ill and young people under the age of 18, and such work is considered exempt from The Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974. Persons for whom enhanced certificates are requested will simultaneously be encouraged to disclose any convictions they have had, both spent and unspent. Disclosure information obtained by both these means will be fully and fairly considered before any persons are engaged in exempt activities with, or through, volunteering organisations reserves the right to take up references.
