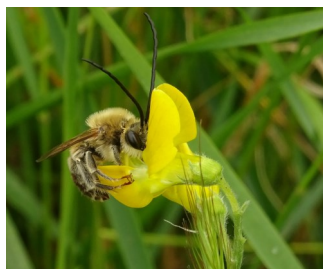
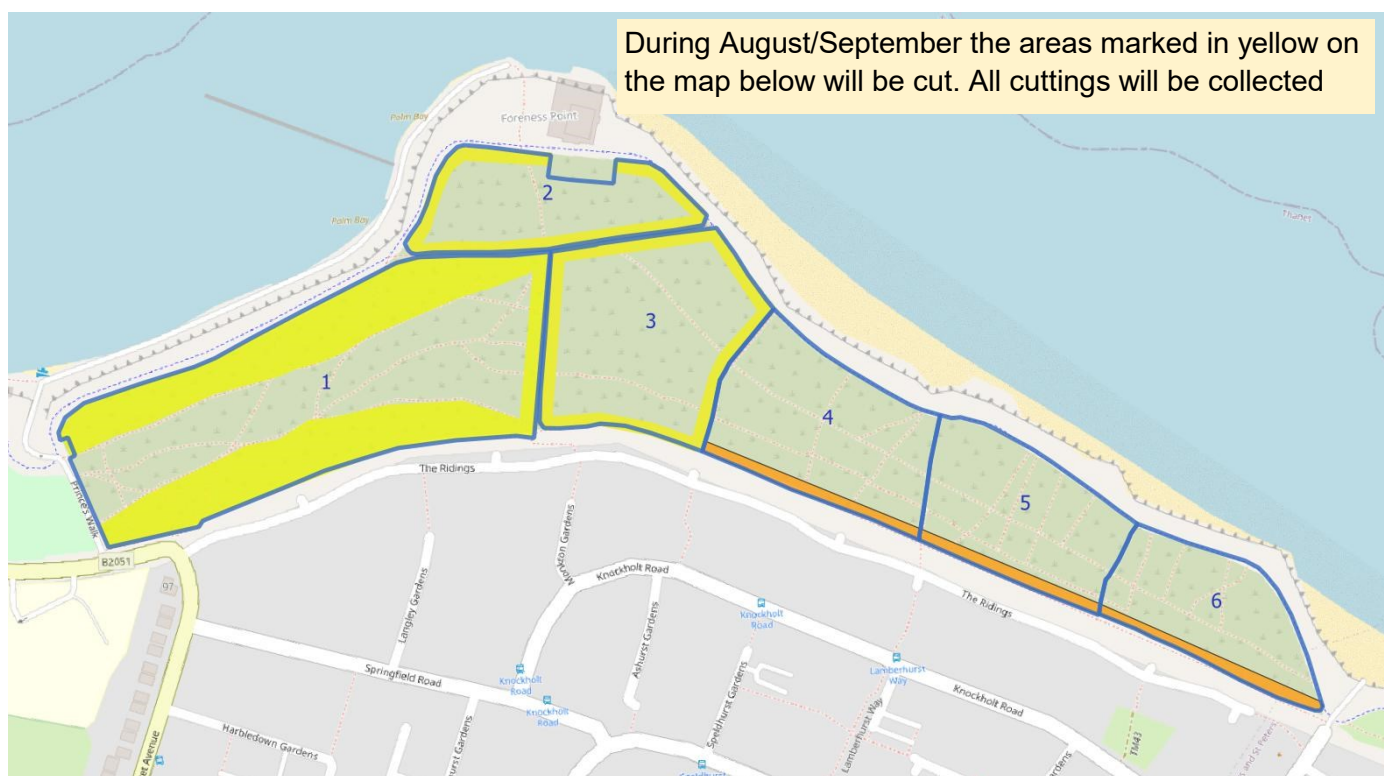


Planned Habitat Management At Foreness Point



- Kent is a hotspot for bumblebees and other bees, including rare and endangered species such as the Shrill Carder Bee
- We are managing and restoring this area to encourage a wide range of wildflowers and other wildlife
- This will mean removing some of the more dominant plants to allow other, less competitive, wildflowers to establish
- Areas of longer grass and flower-rich areas will remain uncut to ensure shelter and food sources remain for bees and other wildlife, including birds.
